The Goals of these Services are to:

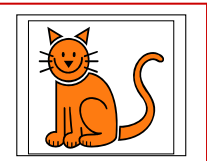
- Assist Job Seekers with disabilities in accessing employment and training programs and, ultimately, achieving employment.

  - Assessment Tools to help identify skills and strengths
  - Specialized software for one handed typing and other needs
  - Capability to convert documents to Braille and print in Braille

  - CC-TV and other magnifying devices for enlarging reading materials
  - TTY/TDD Phone for outgoing calls
  - Assistive Listening Devices
- Other reference books and desk tools, large print dictionary and more
